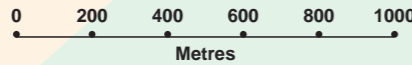


Kununurra



HIDDEN VALLEY (MIRIMA) NATIONAL PARK

Much of the rock in this park is brittle and crumbly. Do not stand on or walk close to cliff edges. Stay on established tracks or if venturing further, ensure that someone knows your proposed route and expected time of return. Be prepared when walking. Wear a hat, sunscreen, sturdy shoes or boots and carry adequate drinking water.



HIDDEN VALLEY (MIRIMA) NATIONAL PARK - An ancient rock formation similar to the Bungle Bungle Range. It provides quiet well-timbered trails along crumbly cliffs, caves and ridges. Many bird species. Walk with care at all times.

ORD IRRIGATION PROJECT - It's a 42km drive through the thriving farm lands that begin outside town. Tours available from the Visitors Centre.

NIMBLEE GALLERY - Souvenirs and art. Displays also feature local Aboriginal and cattle station life.

WARRINGARRI ABORIGINAL ARTS - A large and varied collection of quality crafts and works of art for sale from Kimberley Aboriginal communities.

CROCODILES

Be aware of signs erected at places where crocodiles may be found. Do not:

1. Swim or wade.
2. Clean fish on or near water.
3. Camp next to the water's edge.
4. Allow your pets near the water.
5. Dangle legs or arms over the edge of boats.
6. Stand at the water's edge when fishing.

Absence of warning signs does not signify a safe area. Seek local or expert advice before swimming, camping, fishing or boating.

KUNUNURRA FESTIVALS - During the 'Dry' the town hosts the annual Ord River Festival. Other special events include horse racing, rodeos, an art show, an agricultural show and the dam-to-dam dinghy regatta.

BANDICOOT BEACH - A pleasant grassy beach area with good views of the Diversion Dam wall.

BANDICOOT BAR - A good fishing and picnic spot, but swimming not recommended due to strong currents and saltwater crocodiles. See Crocodile Warning.

DIVERSION DAM - Water fed year round from the Ord River Dam is held behind this dam, whose spill gates provide excellent fishing.

DIVERSION DAM SPILLWAY - An observation deck gives a view of the 2.2 km cut in the rock which carries excess water, especially after rain.

LAKE KUNUNURRA - Formed by the diversion dam, it's a lush lake that winds for many kilometres through the dry hills. Good fishing and nature observation. See Crocodile Warning.

CITY OF RUINS - Viewed from a distance these rock pinnacles and outcrops look like the ruins of an ancient city.

KELLYS KNOB LOOKOUT - Vehicle access to spectacular panoramic views of the town, irrigation area, diversion dam and nearby ranges.

Y.H.A. - swimming pool, shire office & library, tennis.
